On board, we will be offering health services including **NHS Health Checks** and **Stop Smoking Clinics.** Trained staff will provide health testing, advice and help local people access services that promote a healthier lifestyle. This will includes:

- Apples & Pears: help for both adults and children to lose weight
- Smokefreelife Camden: help to stop smoking
- Camden Alcohol Service: advice about drinking
- Give It A Go! free vouchers for leisure centre membership for some residents
- **WISH+:** access to free smoke detectors, well and warm home visits, energy advice, help for older and disabled people and much more
- Lung function test: for lung health
- iCope: for people who feel stressed, anxious or depressed
