Stop Smoking in Pregnancy Specialist (Breathe Stop Smoking Service)

JOB SUMMARY

The Stop Smoking in Pregnancy Specialist (stop smoking advisor) will work within the Breathe Stop Smoking Service in Camden and Islington. The Breathe service is commissioned by Camden and Islington Public Health. It works collaboratively with the midwifery departments of the local NHS Hospital Trusts and supports the wider North Central London (NCL) Smokefree Pregnancy work stream. The post holder will be the main point of contact for referrals of pregnant women from maternity professionals. They will engage pregnant women to access the service; they will motivate and support them to achieve their desired goal of stopping smoking through a combination of home visits, community based and mobile clinics, and the provision of social clubs offering a friendly, relaxed environment for women to receive tailored support during their stop smoking journey.



1. MAI N DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Maintain regular communication and effective working relationships with maternity professionals in the three local NHS Hospital Trusts, in community services and other local partners as needed.
- Work collaboratively with the midwifery teams and the NCL Midwife Champions in the three local NHS Hospital Trusts, to streamline the referral pathway and establish feedback systems to ensure that midwifery teams receive timely feedback on all referrals made to Breathe.
- Work collaboratively with the midwifery teams in the three local NHS Hospital Trusts and the NCL Midwife Champions, to plan, promote and implement two 'Me Time' social clubs for pregnant women, one each in Camden and Islington, based on a model developed by Solutions 4 Health.
- Work to increase the number of referrals of pregnant smokers to the Breathe service, ensuring that all referrals are processed within 24 hours.
- Provide evidence-based behavioural support and pharmacological advice in the community and via home visits to pregnant women who want to stop smoking, in Camden and Islington.

2. P SMOKING SERVICE SPECIALIST PROVISION

- Expl ain to potential clients the principles of Stop Smoking Services, so that they can make an informed choice to use the Breathe service to stop smoking.
- Expl ain to clients the health benefits of quitting smoking in pregnancy and the risks of continuing to smoke.



- Provide evidence-based behavioural support and pharmacological advice in accordance with the National Centre for Smoking Cessation and Training (NCSCT) treatment protocols and Solutions 4 Health guidelines, to those wishing to stop smoking.
- Provide a high quality and efficient service to the diverse communities of Camden and Islington.
- Con tact pregnancy referrals and book in appointments.
- Set up clinics alongside the midwives in local NHS Trusts' Maternity Units.
- Undertake activities in keeping with the guidance set out by babyClear[©], an evidence-based stop smoking intervention to reduce smoking in pregnancy.
- Monitor the effectiveness and outcomes of treatment programmes for clients.
- Be innovative and outcomes-focused, promoting increased access and engagement of smokers, in a variety of community venues across Camden and Islington.
- Ensure adequate provision of stop smoking advice at a range of times, days and locations, including evenings and/or weekends where required by the overall client and/or commissioner demand.
- Plan and organise workload effectively, this will include the management of a caseload, which will include home visits.
- Keep databases and client records up to date, using digital systems for client management, as required.



- Actively seek and participate in promotional events, including face-to-face outreach, texting/calling previous clients or known smokers and other promotional initiatives that engage local smokers.
- Work together with other members of the Breathe team, e.g. using mobile clinics to support local residents in the community.

3. TRAINING AND PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Complete the National Centre for Smoking Cessation and Training (NCSCT) 'Smoking in pregnancy and post-partum period' online module.
- Attend training for stop smoking practitioners provided by babyClear[©] in Camden and Islington.
- Enhance existing competencies and acquire new competencies, in line with agreed personal development plans as part of continuous professional development and the needs of the job.
- Ensure a commitment to own personal development by keeping up to date with research and best practice in smoking cessation.
- The organisation will provide training and materials to set up the "Me time" social club.
- Org anise and provide trainings to midwifery staff.

4. OTHER

Stop Smoking Service



- Day to day administration work will be required as part of this role
- Attend team meetings
- Work at weekends as required and no more than twice a month
- Undertake other duties that relate to this post.

ELIGIBLITY TO WORK IN THE UK
